Position Title: Low Voltage Technician - Fort Myers, FL

PRIMARY PURPOSE & FUNCTION:

The primary job responsibility of the Audio Video Installer is to install audio-video equipment in high-end residential & commercial spaces. Job responsibilities include, but are not limited to: pulling cable, attic crawls in tight-fitting spaces, wire fishing, installing connectors, mounting projects, problem-solving, troubleshooting, and creative thinking. Candidate must be Responsible, Self-Motivated, Self-Starter, Personable, and Well-Organized.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Mount TVs from 43" to 98" on articulating/fixed mounts
- Low voltage wire pulling, repair, and termination for new and retrofit construction projects, as well as finished spaces (Cat 5, 5e, 6, Coax, Fiber Optic Cable, etc)
- Install security camera systems (POE/IP Cameras)
- Drywall modifications including cutting holes for speakers, wall-plates plates, and other applications
- Loading and unloading of equipment to and from work vehicles and job sites
- Be able to regularly climb and work from ladders up to heights of 20 feet; lifting equipment, tools/ materials, loading and unloading equipment weighing at least 75 pounds.
- Test and resolve equipment issues
- Performing work at exacting standards in an efficient manner
- Use of hand and power tools in both new construction and finished environments
- Cabling and cable termination
- Racking and mounting AV devices and control units
- The ability to work independently to troubleshoot technical issues
- Providing Excellent Customer Service
- Provide daily logs and effectively communicate to supervisor about each job
- Keep work area neat, clean and hazard-free
- Keep work vehicles clean, organized, and stocked
- Will work in other areas, as needed for cross-training and/or workload

- Must be flexible enough to safely maneuver through shallow attics and crawl spaces to run low-voltage wires
- Must be able to work from ladders and lifts with arms extended overhead for extended periods of time
