Position Title: Low Voltage Audio Video Technician - Fort Myers, FL

PRIMARY PURPOSE & FUNCTION:

The primary job responsibility of the Low Voltage AV Tech is to install custom audio-video equipment in high end residential & commercial spaces.

Job responsibilities include, but are not limited to, performing installations, service/repair support to customers including technology-related problem solving, troubleshooting, and creative thinking. Candidate must be Responsible, Self-Motivated, Self-Starter, Personable, and Well-Organized.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Mount TVs from 43" to 98" on articulating/fixed mounts
- Install projectors & screens in theater rooms
- Install security camera systems (POE/IP Cameras, DVR/NVR, Port Forwarding)
- Install theater room and whole-house surround sound systems
- Install wired networks (low voltage Cat 5, Cat 6, fiber optic cabling, switches, routers, and other network devices)
- Install, Program and Maintain Residential Network and WiFi Systems (network routers/wireless access points/extenders/mesh/ firewalls)
- Low voltage wire pulling for new and retrofit construction projects, as well as finished spaces
- Use of hand and power tools in both new construction and finished environments
- Lift up to 50lbs
- Cabling and cable termination
- Racking and mounting AV devices and control units
- Installation and setup of rack-mounted A/V equipment such as tuners, receivers, HDMI splitters, switchers, and amplifiers
- The ability to work independently to troubleshoot technical issues

- Provide daily logs and effectively communicate to supervisor about each job
- Keep work area neat, clean and hazard-free
- Keep work vehicles clean, organized, and stocked
